

October 7, 2019 Booster Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by president, Michele Segura at 7 pm.

Standing Reports

September 2019 Minutes were presented for approval. Dee Vester made a motion to approve the minutes. Diane Carroll seconded. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report was presented by Brenda Russell. She reviewed the P&L statement and explained how well we are doing with concessions. There were no questions on the report

Discussions:

Friday, Oct 11 Away Game: Michele talked about the details for the game. The plan to leave at 3 pm on charter buses before the school opens the gates for the parent pick up. All chaperones and kids will be feed when we arrive in Lockhart as well as pizza after the game. Snacks will be provided on the buses on the way to Lockhart.

Saturday, Oct 12 US Bands Competition: Decision was made not to order dinner in advance at competition because we didn't want to commit to expenses until we were sure we made finals. There will be piggies for kids and chaperones in the morning; as well as snacks and Gatorade at competition.

Senior Night: Jennifer Uecker gave status update on planning of senior night. In the past, donations have been solicited for cost of senior signs. **Jennifer Uecker made a motion for the Boosters to pay for the senior signs. Shannon McDonald seconded the motion and all approved. Motion was passed.** Michele mentioned Stan Leech agreed to show a video of the seniors on the big screen during half time. There was a reminder that middle school will also be at the game. Lindsay Laws will give middle school kids a tour shirt at the game. Also a reminder that Thursday night's game is a televised game.

Winter Wonderband: Shannon McDonald said she was working on new centerpieces. Next, she shared all sections were covered with section parents for the raffle basket donations. Work is being done to get ticket sales set up on the website. Tickets will be same as last year: \$10 per student and \$20 for all other. There was discussion about other fundraising opportunities like a wine pull concept slightly adjusted to meet school rules. Michele said she would talk with Mary Grant about making a loop of photos of band events/kids while people are walking into the auditorium and showing the competition show between one of the band switches. Amy Carson, Michele and Vanessa Gonzalez agreed to work on a golf cart solution to help people with needs attend the event. Diana Carroll offered to look into creating a keepsake for the event. No other decisions were made.

Fall Raffle: Shannon Jackson said there will be about 800 tickets for the hunt and diamond necklace – there will be separate raffle tickets /drawings for each prize. Discussion on distribution of packets to students, which will start Nov 7 and run for 2 weeks. There was also discussion about selling tickets the night of the WWB dinner as well as Dickens on Main and during the Christmas Parade. Shannon said she would look into the ideas.
